## Harry A. Miller Club History

Harry A. Miller was born in Menomonie, WI in 1875. His curiosity and genius led him to build his first carburetors and pistons in 1907. Miller gained prominence after moving to Los Angeles, CA where he went on to build his infamous Miller designed engines and cars. His well-known 122 front-wheel-drive racing car was introduced to the public in 1924. Harry Miller is regarded as America's greatest race car and engine designer.

The late David V. Uihlein, Sr. founded the Harry A. Miller Club in 1995 to make sure this Wisconsin native's legacy continued. The Club's annual Millers at Milwaukee – Vintage Indy Car Event offers members the opportunity to run and display their vintage race cars, and to share with the public the history of vintage racing and the accomplishments of Harry A. Miller.

Weekend passes are available for sale the day of the event at the rates below.

*\*\*Children under the age of 16 will not be allowed in the pit area after cars are on the track.*

Participants will receive 2 pit passes with a paid entry fee. Additional pit passes needed for crew must be purchased at discounted rate of \$20 each.

## Location/Parking

The Milwaukee Mile and State Fair Park are located off of I-94 and 84th St. in West Allis, WI. The entrance to the racetrack is through Gate 5, located off of 84th St.

Spectators must enter the track through the tunnel located on Northwest side of the track. Parking is free on the infield. Admission is paid at the end of the tunnel, before entering the infield.

Entrants with trailers must drive around the north end of the track, turn right at the stop sign and cross over the track, entering the infield. The track entrance is open Thurs. afternoon July 7, 2011 from 1 pm - 4 pm, or on July 8 from 8-10 am. Please notify the Miller Club of approximate arrival time, if parking on Thurs. July 7.

## Eligible Cars

All front engine pre and post W.W. II Indy cars and Champ cars are invited to attend, along with Indy Roadster and lay-down cars - no rear engines. Only 60 cars will be accepted.

## Entry Fees

\$300 for the first car entered - This fee includes 2 Pit Passes and 2 Banquet Tickets to the Friday dinner and auction.

\$200 for each additional car entered - This fee includes 2 Pit Passes per car.

Additional banquet tickets can be purchased for \$50 each. Each entrant must also be an active member of the Harry A. Miller Club - with the \$25 membership fee paid for 2011.

## Important Entrant Requirements
